<b>Design Features</b>	The design brief in part was to create a course with the feel of Augusta National Golf Course, the home of the Masters. Nestled amid 250 hectares of Native Australian Forest with multiple pockets of sub-tropical rainforest, the golf course rises and dips through elegant strands of rainforest, each fairway isolated and private from the next
<b>Golf Cart Fleet</b>	A fleet of 80 Club Car Precedent models, purchased in June 2005
<b>Distance Markers</b>	Native Grass Trees are used to indicate approximate distances 1 Grass Tree marks – approx 100 metres to the centre of the green 2 Grass Trees marks – approx 150 metres to the centre of the green 3 Grass Trees marks – approx 200 metres to the centre of the green
<b>Facilities</b>	Driving Range, Practice Fairway, Putting Green, Chipping Bunker 30 accommodation suites situated on the picturesque 1st fairway Award Winning Restaurant (The Flooded Gums), Tournament Bar, On course refreshments cart
