

THE FLOODED GUMS LISTED IN THE 2009 SMH GOOD FOOD GUIDE



The Flooded Gums Restaurant of Bonville Golf Resort has been awarded 14 out of 20 in the highly prestigious Sydney Morning Herald Good Food Guide for 2009. The listing comes just weeks after being awarded 1 Goblet in the Fine Wine Partners Wine List of the Year Awards.

Bonville's General Manager, Brad Daymond explains "the entire Bonville team are extremely proud of being featured in the Good Food Guide. This has been the aim of the Flooded Gums restaurant for many years, as the guide is one of the most respected food/restaurant publications in NSW each year".

The score out of 20 comprises 10 points for food, 5 for service, 3 for ambience with an extra 2 points possible for a 'sprinkling of magic'. The Flooded Gums' 14 was 1 point shy of receiving a coveted 'chefs hat', awarded to restaurants scoring 15 or more. Bonville's partner property Jonah's overlooking Whale Beach on Sydney's Northern Beaches received a score of 15 out of 20 in this year's guide and a 'chef's hat'. Jonah's Executive Chef, George Francisco is also Bonville's consulting chef and has been working very closely with Bonville's Executive Chef Lee O'Carroll and Brad Daymond as to how Bonville can be in the guide and also to win a 'chefs hat'.
