

# MAGNER REIGNS AGAIN AT BONVILLE'S 15TH ANNUAL QANTASLINK LADIES CLASSIC

218 lady golfers contested the 15<sup>th</sup> annual 36-hole QantasLink Ladies Amateur Golf Classic at Bonville Golf Resort in Coffs Harbour over the 18<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup> of February. The event has become a major fixture on the ladies amateur golf calendar with entries from far North Queensland as far west as Alice Springs & as far south as Tasmania. The 2011 field was the biggest field the event has attracted since its inception back in 1997 and sees the ladies vying for over \$11,000 worth of prizes. All while have having fun whilst playing golf of course. Many entrants return from previous years to tackle the challenging Bonville layout and experience one of the few women's only two day tournaments held in Australia, on the award winning layout of Bonville Golf Resort – Voted Australia's most beautiful mainland golf course 10 years in a row by The Golf Course Guide.

Division 1 Winner for the 2011 QantasLink Ladies Amateur Classic and overall Champion was event Veteran Rhonda Magner from Concord Golf Club, showing great ability to bounce back overnight after trailing by a few shots after day 1 and not in the lead group for days 2. Rhonda has been coming to the event year after year and has won the event once in 2009 & placed 2<sup>nd</sup> a staggering 7 times with a gross score for the weekend of 164, Rhonda avoided a playoff defeating fellow Concord Golf Club member Margaret Bain-Smith by 2 shots. Rhonda was ecstatic to again win trophy at Bonville as she loves the course so much that she plays over 10 rounds a year on the challenging layout.
