

STATE'S BEST HERE ON COFFS COAST



Bonville Golf Resort has been announced as NSW's best Public Access Golf Course by Australia's Leading golf publication, Golf Australia Magazine. Bonville has been recognised as the states best for it's course design, course conditions & aesthetics. With the later also seeing the course named as Australia's most beautiful mainland golf course for an amazing 10 years straight by The Golf Course Guide.

This list identified the countries best 100 Public Access Courses from the over 1,100 public access courses available to play a minimum 5 days a week. Bonville has this type of access 7 days a week and will be played by thousands of visitors here on the Coffs Coast over the Summer Holidays looking to play the best of the best of Australia's Public Access Golf courses.

Bonville improved its previous ranking by 2 spots and also places 12 spots higher than its nearest NSW competitor The Vintage in the Hunter Valley in 20th spot with Pacific Dunes at Port Stephens rounding out the States top 3 courses listed as the 28th best. Coffs Harbour (1 – 18 holes) narrowly missed out on making the top 100, placing in the 'Next 20' list after receiving some votes from the 20 strong judging panel.

Bonville's General Manager, Brad Daymond commented that "This ranking reflects the ongoing improvements to both the golf course itself and the 'Bonville Experience' and sees us as only 1 of 2 courses in the top 10 that improved their position with many others slipping. The past 12 months have seen our Course Superintendent Chris Neal and his energetic team working tirelessly on completing a bunker refurbishment program (all up reshaping, designing & replacing drainage in all 60 bunkers on course), as well as increasing the level of daily presentation, overall consistency and general conditioning of the golf course. These factors have all contributed to Bonville climbing in rankings such as this.
